# Te Pūtake Purpose of Industry Support funding

Te Māngai Pāho Industry Support funding is aligned to the Creators key focus area published in the Te Māngai Pāho <u>Statement of Performance Expectations</u> for 2025/26; providing funding support to reo Māori content creators and related professionals for initiatives that benefit the reo Māori content industry and workforce.

# Ngā Hiahia Matua Priorities

The following are areas of **priority** for Industry Support investment:

- 1. Capacity & Capability Building
- 2. Partnership
- 3. Sponsorship
- 4. Quick Response

Other initiatives will be considered based on need, demand or innovation.

# Ngā Paearu Kuhu Eligibility

Each priority has its own criteria. Applicants must submit an initial enquiry to support@tmp.govt.nz for a Kaihāpai (Advisor) to review. Interested applicants are advised to supply information kaupapa details and applicant eligibility in their enquiry. A Kaihāpai must confirm eligibility before an application can be made.

### Capacity & Capability Building

#### **Funding For**

An initiative that assists professional development of personnel or organisations working within the media or content production sectors.

#### **Application Process**

Applicants are advised to submit an initial enquiry to <a href="mailto:support@tmp.govt.nz">support@tmp.govt.nz</a>. Please provide information to demonstrate that you meet the eligibility criteria, along with some general details about the kaupapa and why you believe Te Māngai Pāho should support this initiative. A Kaihāpai will need to assess the initial enquiry and confirm eligibility before you can submit a full application and proposal.

If eligible, you will be invited to apply for Capacity & Capability Building support. You will need to be registered in Te Pūahatanga to complete an application form and upload a proposal.

- a Māori-led media or content production business to grow its staff capacity or capability?

- a Māori-led media or content production business to expand its market prospects?

Please provide information to demonstrate that you meet the eligibility criteria, along with some general details about the kaupapa you're proposing, and why you believe Te Māngai Pāho will make a good partner. A Kaihāpai will need to assess the initial enquiry and confirm eligibility before you can submit a full application and proposal. We may contact you for further information.

If eligible, you will be invited to apply for Partnership support. You will need to be registered in Te Pūahatanga to complete an application form and upload a proposal.

If eligible, you will be invited to apply for Sponsorship support. You will need to be registered in Te Pūahatanga to complete an application form and upload a proposal.

An initial approval for a contribution <u>up to</u> \$25,000.00 (ex GST) can be given, with the final funding contribution subject to Te Māngai Pāho approval of actual costs and invoices.

Please provide information to demonstrate that you meet the eligibility criteria, along with some general details about the kaupapa, and why Te Māngai Pāho is needed to support the kaupapa. A Kaihāpai will need to assess the initial enquiry and confirm eligibility before you can submit a full application and proposal.

If eligible, you will be invited to apply for Quick Response support. You will need to be registered in Te Pūahatanga to complete an application form and upload a proposal.

To apply, you must first register in <u>Te Pūahatanga</u>, the online system operated by Te Māngai Pāho. Registrations can take up to three days to process so we encourage applicants to register well in advance of the funding deadline. Applicants will not be able to submit applications until all required fields are completed. You can save your application at any time throughout the process and come back to edit it via your dashboard right up to the deadline.

Only applications submitted in Te Pūahatanga will be considered for funding.
